Frequently Asked Questions

My child is entering kindergarten this fall. Can he or she register for Soccer Nights?

No, your child does not make the age cut off for the 2010 North Cambridge Soccer Nights. The program is for children ages 6-12 years old. However, your child is still eligible if he or she is 5 years old AND entering first grade this fall.

Can my four or five year old still participate at Soccer Nights?

While your child cannot participate in the Soccer Nights programming and nightly soccer instruction, we will have some informal activities on the sidelines. We encourage parents to stay and participate in these activities with their children.

Can my child (under six years of age) have a free Soccer Nights t-shirt?

No, we have a limited number of t-shirts intended for registered participants only. You can purchase a t-shirt for \$5, but we cannot give extra shirts away for free.

What time is Soccer Nights?

Soccer Nights runs weeknights this week from 6-8:30PM. Registration & check-in open at 5:30PM

Does my child need to wear soccer cleats?

Not at all, your child should just wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothes to run around in.

When does registration close for Session 2?

New participants can register on-site at Russell Park Field through Wednesday.

Check in with your child's team coach at 8:30PM to pick up your child for the evening. If you have given your child permission to walk, or ride his or her bike home, you must communicate that to registration volunteers when you first check-in at 5:30PM.

If I registered my child for Session 1 is he or she automatically registered for Session 2?
